A MINIMUM of a one time \$500 scholarship will be awarded

The Tu Es Belle “Big Screen” - **Cultural Edition** Scholarship was established in 2017 as part of an initiative to help support the financial reoccurring gap for students of Haitian descent. The scholarship’s purpose is to assist students as they embark on their new educational journey by providing funds to contribute towards their college expenses.

The awarded student will receive a **minimum** of \$500.00. This award can be used at any accredited college or university in the United States.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Applicant is of Haitian descent**
- Applicant**
 - Must demonstrate excellent character and or show he/she has helped others through community organizations, church, S.T.E.M. programs, school, music or the arts
 - Applicant must be a resident of Palm Beach, Broward or Dade County
 - Applicant must be a high school graduating senior
